

St. Pius X Campus Uniform Policy

St. Pius X Campus requires that the students in Grades 1 through 5 attend school appropriately dressed and groomed in such a way as to promote self-dignity, pride and self-worth as they go about being representatives of the school. Parents' taking the responsibility for their child's following of the dress code will form the successful implementation of these standards. If in doubt about the acceptability of an item of clothing, please contact the Principal **before allowing** your child to wear the item to school.

The dress code, as described below, prohibits the wearing of oversized, baggy or tight clothes and with the exception of the gym uniform, all collared or turtleneck shirts **must be tucked in**. When wearing slacks/shorts **with belt loops**, a properly-fitting, solid-colored, **dark belt must be worn**, except when a sweater or sweatshirt is worn over the slacks/shorts. No suspenders are allowed, **No logos, decals or designs (except St. Pius logo)** are allowed on any pants, tops, sweatshirt, t-shirts, sweatpants or shoes. Articles of clothing **must be labeled with the child's name**.

ENFORCEMENT

Students are expected to be in proper uniform every day. This includes wearing their shirts tucked in at all times. At this grade level the parent/guardian is responsible to ensure that the child is in compliance with our uniform/dress code when they are brought to school. The principal and teachers will monitor the students' compliance during the school day. Students, who come to school not in proper uniform/dress code, will be reminded of what needs to be corrected. (Consideration will be given to the age of the child). A Uniform Policy Violation Check List will be sent home to the parent or guardian and must be signed and returned the following school day. (A copy of this form being sent home will be given to S. Carol Jean). Each subsequent time a student continues to show up to school not in proper uniform, the parent or guardian will be called. An action plan correcting the situation will be created.

Sweaters	Solid color red, white or navy blue cardigans, pull-over sweaters, sweater vests. A collared shirt or turtleneck must be worn under sweater. (Hooded sweaters are not allowed.)	Same	Available through area department stores or The Uniform Place
Sweatshirts	Solid color red, white or navy blue with St. Pius logo. A collared shirt or turtleneck must be worn under sweatshirt. On gym days, a t-shirt may be worn underneath. Shoes	Brown or black dress shoes with a non-marking sole or a tennis shoe that is solid white, solid black or a combination of black and white. No shoes/boots above ankle height, high tops, hiking boots, fashion boots, sandals, open-toe or open-heel shoes, or clogs. All shoes with laces must be fully laced and tied.
